Power of Preservation in Indian Country Leadership Seminar

National Conservation and Training Center (NCTC)

Shepherdstown, West Virginia

May 31, 2015, through June 5, 2015

Lodging and Transportation Basic Information

NCTC has entered into an agreement with NATHPO for participant lodging starting on Sunday, May 31, 2015, and checking out either Thursday, June 4, or Friday, June 5, 2015.

Important dates and times:

- Sunday, May 31, 2015: All participants must arrive no later than this date.
Introductions and Overview are 7-8:30pm.
- Thursday, June 4, 2015: Seminar concludes by 12noon.
- Friday, June 5, 2015: Morning discussion on NATHPO projects (optional)

Lodging Information – Reserving a Room at NCTC:

- ▶ Upon your successful application and acceptance as a participant, NATHPO will inform NCTC to expect a phone call from each accepted participant, who will confirm lodging dates and payment method.
- ▶ Daily room rate – which includes all your meals – is \$152/night
- ▶ NCTC's street address is 698 Conservation Way, Shepherdstown, WV 25443

Airport:

- ▶ Dulles International Airport (airplane code is IAD)

Getting to/from Dulles Airport and NCTC:

- ▶ NCTC offers a roundtrip shuttle to/from Dulles airport for \$100. This is a good rate – Dulles is about 50 miles away from NCTC.
- ▶ You will *not* need a rental car during the seminar.
- ▶ If you have a late arrival or early departure from Dulles, many travelers will stay at a hotel near the airport.

Shepherdstown Travel Tips:

- ▶ Average weather in June is in the 70s.
- ▶ Can be strong thunder and lightning storms in the late spring
